

Dr Oliver Mayo - BioAngels

Oliver Mayo is an Honorary Research Fellow CSIRO Animal, Food and Health Sciences and an Adjunct Professor in the Faculty of the Sciences, University of Adelaide, South Australia. He is an active member of BioAngels, an experienced angel group specialising in biotech. He has experience of commercialising technology from the public sector, as well as from the investing side.

He is a former research leader with CSIRO with over 40 years of experience in the areas of applied statistics and genetics, especially applied to animal production and plant breeding. He was the Chief of CSIRO Animal Production from 1989 to 1998. Before that, he was Dean, Faculty of Agricultural Science, University of Adelaide, 1986-7.

He has published over 100 research papers in refereed journals and has written a number of books on topics ranging from Australian wine through biography and evolution by natural selection to the theory of plant breeding.

He is a: Fellow, Australian Academy of Science; Fellow, Australian Academy of Technological Sciences and Engineering; and Foreign Member, Russian Academy of Agricultural Science.
